## **Question Patterns**

#### Pattern 1

#### **Best Practice Question**

- Question description is general
- Referring to a definition or a process
- Look for keywords: characteristic; which is not....?; what should you do first....?;

#### Pattern 2

Specific Question, Solving Specific Problem

- Description defines a unique situation with a specific problem
- Amongst the answers look for a "real" next step, "real" action
- Look for keywords: there is 2 weeks delay; we decided to optimize resources





- Exam date: Alfred: Dec 7<sup>th</sup>, did it online; Josh: Dec 1<sup>st</sup>, did it online
- When did you started exam prep? Alfred: started in Nov, only 1 month; Josh: started in Sep, 2 months prep
- Prep materials: **Alfred**: Joseph Philipps Udemy course, Gabor Weekly Study Group ©; **Josh**: Joseph Philipps Udemy course, Gabor Weekly Study Group ©, attended 1on1 call very little focus on PMI books
- What was your passing %? **Alfred**: full mock test 70-79%; **Josh**: full mock test 87%

- Lesson learned: doing it at home make sure "checklist" (environment) is completed advise: to do the exam in test center; CAPM questions were more situational; do not flag too many questions for review; use elimination technique; joining study group and all the sharing and able to ask questions

- Exam date: 28/10/2023, went to test center, got results right away
- When did you started exam prep? Started before(June) exam format changed; Joined study group by August
- Prep materials: Andrew Ramdayal CAPM course, Pocket Prep Pro, also PM-Prepcast
- How the study group made a difference? Discussions, question explanations, drag & drop questions, understanding concept
- What was your passing %? 75-82%
- Exam experience? Going test center is must have; utilized the break, finished 30 min earlier
- Lesson learned: Had a 1-on-1 call with Gabor; followed exam strategy we discussed; 8 weeks study plan was very useful; More questions you do it helps you to better concepts do not timed questions prior the exam, instead just do more practice questions, got few(6) earned value questions



- Exam date: 12/9/2023; went to test center
- When did you started exam prep? Mid July 8 weeks

- Joined 1-on-1 coaching problem with Gabor

- How the study group made a difference? Joined June 20<sup>th</sup>, had great experience ⊕, attended weekly, also FREE call was useful
- What was your passing %? Around 76%-78%, highest 82%
- Exam experience? Was easier than expected ©; calculation questions around 5(only basics); 1 x drag & drop; 2 x multiple choice answer; BA: requirements handling, managing stakeholders


